Attendances

while we understand that illness and scheduling conflicts sometimes arise, we cannot overlook the importance of being present to deepen and grow in the understanding of our Faith. If absent, student will be required to complete the missed work and submit to the DRE. Additionally, every students must attend at least 28 hours of religious formation (a combination of Sunday Ed classes, Faith Formation Fridays, Parish Penitential Services, and liturgically themed monthly opportunities – schedule and information about each of these will be discussed at the Parents’ Meeting on the first day of class, which if possible will take place on September 13, 2020, immediately after the 9AM Mass). Please note that the Sunday class session begins immediately after the 9AM Mass. Students should be in the classroom and ready to start by 9:50AM and are dismissed at 11AM.

Behaviors

We work to ensure that the environment is conducive for a peaceful learning Catechists invest a lot of time in their lessons and they are grateful to be able to work with your children. Not that we foresee any problem with behavior, but please be advised that the following discipline policy will apply to all students who attend Religious Education classes at Good Shepherd.

1. A student will receive a warning in the classroom by the catechist or Aide
2. If the behavior continues, the student will be sent to the DRE office to discuss behavior, and he/she is responsible to make up any missed work before the next class. The parents will be called.
3. If the student is sent to the office a 2nd time during the year, same as above, the parent will be asked to come in for a meeting to discuss how to best rectify future disturbance in the class.
4. If the student is sent to the office a 3rd time during the year, the parent will be asked to homeschool his/her child.
5. There is a zero tolerance for bullying.
